## ***A Typical LDC Session Schedule***

**(Class years run each September through June)**

### **Opening Retreat - Overnight**

*Here, class members will develop a sense of community and sharing, beginning the process of discovery and enlightenment about interpersonal communication and about themselves.*

### **History**

*Class members learn a geological as well as a sociological history of Door County.*

### **Human Services & the Legal System**

*A panel of experts from the legal community and social services walk through the process and consequences of a particular topical scenario.*

### **Education**

*Local educators discuss current issues facing their schools and students. Participants work in teams to discuss how the educational system can meet the challenges within the community.*

### **Health Care**

*A review of local health care providers and health-related issues, their successes and shortcomings.*

### **The Arts & Communication**

*Communicating through public speaking and a study of Door County artists, theater and music.*

### **The Economy & The Environment**

*The relationship between Door County's economy and the environment is examined. Both vital concerns in our community, the development of a balance between these often competing forces is explored.*

### **Community Trusteeship & Commencement Event**

*This session brings closure to the program. Class members are issued a challenge to exercise the skills they've acquired. The day concludes with a dinner and program including commencement and the group project report.*
